Dear Parent/Guardian:

The summer is over and it is time to get back into another school year. I wanted to send out a brief note so you know what to expect in your son/daughter's math class this year.

All students need to have a notebook, folder, and graphing calculator with them for every class along with something to write with (preferably a pencil). Students will have homework most night but assignments are kept to manageable lengths (10-15 problems) and the assignments are planned to take a maximum of 45 minutes to complete. We will go over the solutions to homework problems every day and I will randomly as for these assignments to be turned in throughout the year. Students will also have graded homework assignments approximately once a week. Any homework (Daily or Graded) that is turned in within 1 school day late will be accepted for half credit. After 1 school day no credit can be earned.

Extra help is available to students if they stop to see me during one of my free periods. If before school or after school help is needed that can be arranged by setting up an appointment with me. If you find that your son/daughter is struggling with a concept encourage them to seek help before they fall behind.
